

# ELVEDEN PARISH COUNCIL

## Minutes of the meeting of Elveden Parish Council held on Wednesday, 15<sup>th</sup> March 2023, at 7.30pm in Elveden Estate Office Meeting Room

Present: Cllrs Rob Minty (Chair), Rebecca Younge and Hugo Nugent. Also in attendance, Cllrs Colin Noble (SCC), Victor Lukaniuk, and Stephen Frost.

1. **APOLOGIES** Cllr Colleen Billing
2. **MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING.**  
The minutes of the previous meeting held on Wednesday, 18th January 2023 were agreed and signed as a true record.
3. **MATTERS ARISING**  
There were none.
4. **SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL AND WEST SUFFOLK COUNCIL NEWS**  
Cllr Noble, Cllr Lukaniuk, and Cllr Frost each gave a report on various items from Suffolk County Council and West Suffolk Council.
5. **RURAL CRIME**  
There were five recorded crimes for January – the most recent available figures from the police. All crimes had taken place within Centre Parcs.
6. **BYWAY CLOSURE**  
Byway 1 in Elveden had been closed for safety reasons due to unsafe ground conditions. Access remained open for pedestrians only. It was intended that the closure would operate until at least 14/08/2023 or longer if necessary.
7. **VEHICLE ACTIVATED SPEED SIGN**  
The Clerk presented the council with the list of criteria for the siting of a vehicle activated speed sign, noting that the more criteria that could be matched, the more likely the site would be approved. Councillors agreed to investigate possible locations.
8. **FINANCIAL MATTERS**

9. **PLANNING APPLICATIONS**

Planning application **SCC/0042/21SE** – Alternative Access Road into North Farm Quarry, Barnham, IP24 2PH.

This application was considered by the Development and Regulation Committee on 1<sup>st</sup> February 2023. The Committee resolved to REFUSE consent.

Planning application **SCC/0095/20SE** – Extraction of sand and gravel and subsequent importation of inert waste material to achieve a beneficial restoration of the site back to heathland on land at North Farm, Barnham, IP24 2PH.

This application was considered by the Development and Regulation Committee on 1<sup>st</sup> February 2023. The Committee resolved to REFUSE consent.
